

Jarvis Township Meeting
April 19, 2022

Opening of the Town and Road & Bridge Meeting.

Meeting was called to order by Supervisor Andrea May.

The meeting started with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll call was taken, Trustees Scott Wiesehan, Jason Helldoerfer, Nathan Hovatter and Monica Hartlein were in attendance. Also in attendance was Supervisor Andrea May, Highway Road Commissioner Dale Grapperhaus, Assessor Jessica Dudley and Township Clerk Alan Dunstan.

Motion was made by Scott Wiesehan and seconded by Jason Helldoerfer to accept the minutes of the January Board Meeting. All voted aye on voice vote.

Motion made by Nathan Hovatter and seconded by Monica Hartlein to approve the claims for both the Town and Road Funds. Roll call taken, all voting aye.

Under Action Items:

Supervisor May informed the Board that their Economic Interest Statements are due by May 1st.

A motion was made by Jason Helldoerfer and seconded by Nathan Hovatter to pay the Stutz the amount of \$191,451.50 for the first phase of Country Land. The culvert work is done. Roll call taken, all voting aye.

The Township also approved the Window Replacement at the Township Office. Wilke Window and door will do the work for \$13,100.40. Motion was made by Monica Hartlein and seconded by Jason Helldoerfer. Roll call taken, all voting aye.

Under New Business:

Jarvis Township is entering an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Troy to purchase a Roller for the Road District. The cost should be around \$20,000.

The Township also has a lease agreement to put Township Antenna on the City Water Tower.

Road Commissioner Dale Grapperhaus reported that Phase 2 of the Country Lane Improvements will include the overlay work, and will start soon.

Motion was made by Jason Helldoerfer and seconded by Scott Wiesehan to adjourn the meeting. All voted aye. The next meeting will be held on May 17, 2022.
