

Jarvis Township Meeting
February 21, 2023

Opening of the Town and Road & Bridge Meeting.

Meeting was called to order by Supervisor Andrea May.

The meeting started with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll call was taken, Trustees Scott Wiesehan, Monica Hartlein, Nathan Hovatter and Jason Helldoerfer were in attendance. Also in attendance were Supervisor Andrea May, Road Commissioner Dale Grapperhaus and Township Clerk Alan Dunstan.

Motion was made by Scott Wiesehan and seconded by Jason Helldoerfer to accept the minutes of the January Board Meeting. All voted aye on voice vote.

Motion made by Nathan Hovatter and seconded by Monica Hartlein to approve the claims for both the Town and Road Funds. Roll call taken, all voting aye.

Under Action Items:

The Township will be using Utilitra – migration of e-mail hosting. The cost is \$260.00 a year.

Under New Business:
